## Instruction

1. <u>Compatible OBDII vehicle</u> — Connect the clamps to battery. Then, the green light of battery connection lamp turns on.

Plug ECU Saver to OBDII connector of vehicle. (put Ignition key off)

Non-compatible OBDII vehicle – Turn the ignition key to "ACC". Plug the cigar jack cable to cigar jack of vehicle.


2. Pull out the negative terminal(–) of a battery in vehicle.
