# CASHEWS

The cashew tree is a tropical evergreen tree that produces the cashew seed and the cashew apple. The crop is native to Brazil and was brought to India by Portugese Missionaries in the 16th Century. It is widely grown in the Konkan region of Maharashtra, Goa, Karnataka, Kerela, Odisha and Tamil Nadu in India.
