Greetings, as you see from the email below, we have had previous contact.

I'm happy to report that our installation went smoothly, we now have a plumber who is a 'convert' to the product and is enthusiastically mentioning it to his clients whenever appropriate (name, Michael Anderson, Stirling).

Moreover, it has proven itself twice already, once with a cistern that continued to fill (and flow out, no damage done) and the other time was when a tap was left running slightly. Both times, it cut off as intended. What better proof could one ask for?

I am now looking at possibly getting two more, for installation in a house in France (Saint-Dié-des-Vosges) and another in Spain (Oliva), so potentially two more plumbers to convert :-)

The French one is for a 22 mm supply pipe, standard; the Spanish one, I have been advised, is a 25 mm polyethylene pipe, so what would you recommend for that connection?

Do you have any problem over marketing territories with that scenario, such that I'd have to buy in-country?
